Fourth, you have a support system through life's

- "For if they fall, the one will lift up his fellow: but woe to him that is alone when he falleth; for he hath not another to help him up." Ecclesiastes 4:10
- Everybody wants to be loved and cared about, especially when $\qquad$ gets tough.


## Fifth, you receive the accountability that you need to

- We all need a few people who love us enough to tell us what we $\qquad$ to hear and not what we $\qquad$ to hear. People who have a close enough relationship with us to do that.
