## Verse 15

1.	When this verse talks about Christ spoiling principalities and powers, it is
	speaking of Christ's victory over and his demonic host.
2.	There was a hidden in the cross work of Christ. There are
	veiled references to the cross in a few Old Testament passages, but the
	full extent of what Christ would do and what would be accomplished, God
	kept a 1 Corinthians 2:7-8
3.	In due time, God revealed the full extent of the cross work to
	"Who [Christ] gave himself a ransom for all, to be testified in due
	time. Whereunto I am ordained a preacher, and an apostle, (I
	speak the truth in Christ, and lie not;) a teacher of the Gentiles in
	faith and verity." 1 Timothy 2:6-7
4.	Satan was the originator of sin and death, and is said to have had the
	power of (Hebrews 2:14). Satan thought, "If I can use my power
	of death to also kill the Messiah, I will be assured of ultimate victory."
5.	But to Satan's chagrin, the changed everything. The cross
	took the law out of the way, paid the price for sin, and made possible the
	reconciliation of not only mankind, but the entire earth and universe.
	"Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood,
	he [Christ] also himself likewise took part of the same; that through
	death he might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the
	devil." Hebrews 2:14
6.	He made a complete and satisfactory payment for the sins of the world!
