- Paul charges Timothy to war a good warfare.
- The word "warfare" comes from a Greek word from which we get our English word "\_\_\_\_\_\_." We are soldiers for Christ, and we have an adversary Satan.
- "Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might. Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil."
  Ephesians 6:10-11
- We had better have an effective strategy.
- Every believer must war a good warfare. How can we do this? The apostle Paul lays out a strategy for us.
