1.	When Paul says "because we would not be chargeable unto any of you" he		
	simply means that he did not want to be any kind of a financial upon		
	the people.		
2.	Paul must have been in Thessalonica for several months, day		
	and night, so he could preach the gospel. This was common for Paul. Acts 18:3,		
	20:34		
3.	He had a burning fire and for the ministry of the gospel, and he		
	would not be deterred.

	given in Christ.
