В.	The law did not arrive until 430 years later. No third party (namely, the law) can					
	break or disannul the covenant that God established with Abraham. It was					
	established on the basis of alone.

	promises in Genesis 12:1-3, 13:14-16, 15:5, 17:6-8, 22:17-18.					
B.	. In Paul's epistles, he discusses two seeds:					
	The seed of Abraham – all of those who have been saved					
	by faith in Christ. Galatians 3:7, 29
