- A. God and Abraham made an agreement. Promises were made and received and the Abrahamic covenant between God and Abraham was established.
- B. The law did not arrive until 430 years later. No third party (namely, the law) can break or disannul the covenant that God established with Abraham. It was established on the basis of _____ alone.

Verse 16

- A. God made Abraham some definite promises. You can read about these promises in Genesis 12:1-3, 13:14-16, 15:5, 17:6-8, 22:17-18.
- B. In Paul's epistles, he discusses two seeds:
- The _____ seed of Abraham – all of those who have been saved by faith in Christ. Galatians 3:7, 29

- The _____ seed of Abraham. Romans 11:1; 2 Corinthians 11:22;
Hebrews 2:16
