

# Bible Study Series: The Book of Galatians

## Chapter 3

### Verses 25-26

- A. The law can no longer make any \_\_\_\_\_ of us or condemn us – we are no longer under the schoolmaster. vs. 25; Romans 6:14, 7:4, 6
- B. We are now the children of God by faith in Jesus Christ. vs. 26
- This is the \_\_\_\_\_ in a nutshell.
  - \_\_\_\_\_ in Christ is the difference between a child of God and a child of the devil. Romans 3:25-28, 4:5, 5:1-2, 9:30; Ephesians 2:8-9

### Verse 27

- A. This verse is \_\_\_\_\_ speaking of water baptism. A person is not placed in Christ when he/she is baptized in \_\_\_\_\_.
- B. So, what does it mean to be baptized into Christ?
- The Holy Spirit baptizes \_\_\_\_\_ believers into Christ's body.  
1 Corinthians 12:12-27
- C. If we have been baptized into Christ, we have "put on Christ."
- D. We now have such a \_\_\_\_\_ with Christ that Ephesians 5:30 declares that "...we are members of his body, of his flesh, and of his bones."

### Verse 28

- A. This verse must have shocked a lot of people. It is teaching that we all stand \_\_\_\_\_ before God in Christ. God sees us all "\_\_\_\_\_."
- B. Paul says, "...for ye are all one in Christ Jesus." cf. Colossians 3:11; Romans 10:12
- C. This does not mean that we lose our identity as a man or a woman or we forfeit our national identity when we get saved. Paul clearly addressed these issues in other places, and made these physical distinctions.
- D. God's purposes for all of us are varied and different, but nobody in the body of Christ enjoys a privileged \_\_\_\_\_ before God over other believers. We all have equal \_\_\_\_\_ to the Father through Christ. Ephesians 2:16-18

## Verse 29

- A. Christ was Abraham's seed.
- B. God has baptized us into Christ; therefore we are the \_\_\_\_\_ seed of Abraham.
- C. The spiritual blessings of life and righteousness now \_\_\_\_\_ to us because we are in Christ.
- D. This in no way changes the promises that God made to the physical seed of Abraham (the nation of Israel.) All of those earthly promises will be fulfilled \_\_\_\_\_ . Psalm 89:28-37

- *“For I would not, brethren, that ye should be ignorant of this mystery, lest ye should be wise in your own conceits; that blindness in part is happened to Israel, until the fulness of the Gentiles be come in.  
And so all Israel shall be saved: as it is written, there shall come out of Sion the Deliverer, and shall turn away ungodliness from Jacob:  
For this is my covenant unto them, when I shall take away their sins.  
As concerning the gospel, they are enemies for your sakes: but as touching the election, they are beloved for the father's sakes.”* **Romans 11:25-28**
