1.	When Paul talks about walking "honestly toward them that are without," he is
	referring to those outside of the local church; in the
	community.
2.	Paul says, "walk honestly." Believers should be the ethical,
	hard-working, honest people on earth.
	"Recompense to no man evil for evil. Provide things honest in the sight of all
	men." Romans 12:17
3.	Paul says that we work that we "may have lack of nothing."
	• The Christian is not to be dependent on for their material needs,
	but he is to secure his own livelihood by honest, hard work.
	2 Thessalonians 3:10, 12
