## Bible Study Series: The Book of Galatians Chapter 5

## Verses 19-21

- A. Paul has explained that there are two ways to live life:
  - Walking in the \_\_\_\_\_\_

- B. When a person attempts to live the Christian life by the law instead of by faith, Paul shows us the result in verses 19-21. Paul calls this list the *"works of the flesh."*
- C. Verse 19 deals primarily with \_\_\_\_\_\_ sins.
  - Christians can find themselves in \_\_\_\_\_\_to every kind of sexual sin. 2 Corinthians 12:21
- D. Verse 20 deals more with sins of the \_\_\_\_\_.
  - These sins not only destroy the person who harbors them, but they also destroy \_\_\_\_\_\_ in the home, the workplace, and the church.
  - Christians can find themselves in bondage to all of these sins.
    1 Corinthians 3:3
- E. Paul had taught the Galatians that people who constantly live their life by the works of the flesh shall not inherit the kingdom of God.
  - Paul taught that God's kingdom is manifested in believers' \_\_\_\_\_\_\_
     today. Romans 14:17
  - God's kingdom is not a physical rule over the earth, but a \_\_\_\_\_\_\_
     rule in the believer's heart.
- G. We cannot obtain the kingdom (rule) of God in our lives when we are walking after the \_\_\_\_\_. This is the point Paul is making.
- H. This is why verse 22 begins with, "But the fruit of the Spirit is..."
