# 1 Thessalonians Chapter 5

## Verse 22

- The word "appearance" carries the idea that if something can be viewed in any way to be \_\_\_\_\_, stay away from it.
  - "For your obedience is come abroad unto all men. I am glad therefore on your behalf: but yet I would have you wise unto that which is good, and simple concerning evil." Romans 16:19
  - The word *"simple"* means "\_\_\_\_\_."
- 2. \_\_\_\_\_ is a man in the Bible who did not abstain from all appearance of evil and it cost him dearly.
  - "And delivered just Lot, vexed with the filthy conversation of the wicked."
    2 Peter 2:7
  - "(For that righteous man dwelling among them, in seeing and hearing, vexed his righteous soul from day to day with their unlawful deeds.)" **2 Peter 2:8**
- 3. When we \_\_\_\_\_ our righteous souls with the words and deeds of this world system, it destroys us, just as it did Lot. 1 John 2:15-16

# Verse 23

- 1. In chapter 4 we discussed the issue of *"sanctification"* and that the word is speaking of holiness or \_\_\_\_\_.
- Paul was praying for God to sanctify them wholly. This simply means "\_\_\_\_\_\_ to the end."
  - "Being confident of this very thing, that he which hath begun a good work in you will perform it until the day of Jesus Christ." Philippians 1:6

# Verse 24

1. Paul was very confident that God would continue His work of sanctification in these people.

Isn't it wonderful that God is \_\_\_\_\_, even when we aren't?
 cf. 1 Corinthians 1:7-9; Philippians 1:6

#### Verse 25

This is such a simple, yet precious verse. Paul knew that he stood in need of
 \_\_\_\_\_ and desired the prayers of the saints.

#### Verse 26

• Obviously, this was a standard form of \_\_\_\_\_\_ in that culture. Notice, it says "brethren."

## Verse 27

- 1. It is interesting that Paul desired *"that this epistle be read unto all the holy brethren,"* not just the pastors or spiritual leaders.
- 2. God knows \_\_\_\_\_\_ of a privileged group called "the clergy" which keeps the Word of God out of the hand of the common man or woman.

#### Verse 28

- 1. Paul's desire was that the grace that had saved them be manifested in the local assembly.
- 2. This is God's desire. God desires for His \_\_\_\_\_\_ to abound and be what is seen in the local assembly of believers.
