

# Bible Study Series: The Book of Galatians

## Chapter 6

### Verse 13

- A. Paul continues to reveal the heart of the Judaizers. Paul exposes their sheer hypocrisy.
- B. They wanted to place the yoke of the law on these Gentile believers, yet they themselves could not \_\_\_\_\_ the law.
- *“Forasmuch as we have heard, that certain which went out from us have troubled you with words, subverting your souls, saying, Ye must be circumcised, and keep the law: to whom we gave no such commandment.”*  
**Acts 15:24**
  - *“Now therefore why tempt ye God, to put a yoke upon the neck of the disciples, which neither our fathers nor we were able to bear?”* **Acts 15:10**

### Verse 14

- A. Paul proclaims that he will not glory (boast) in anything other than the cross of the Lord Jesus Christ.
- B. To Paul, the cross was not an \_\_\_\_\_ or picture. It was a reality. When Paul refers to the cross, he is referring to the finished work of \_\_\_\_\_ that was accomplished on the cross.
- C. The “by whom” makes clear that Paul is referring to the \_\_\_\_\_ of the cross, not a physical emblem to be revered, worshipped, or admired.
- D. Paul says, “...by whom the world is crucified unto me, and I unto the world.”
- E. “The world” speaks of the \_\_\_\_\_ world system that is operative on the earth today.
- F. As believers in Christ, God’s Spirit has placed us into Christ, and we are no longer part of this \_\_\_\_\_ system. Galatians 1:4; Colossians 1:13-14
- *“And the Lord shall deliver me from every evil work, and will preserve me unto his heavenly kingdom: to whom be glory for ever and ever.”*  
**2 Timothy 4:18**

- When a Christian loves the world and lives like this world is his \_\_\_\_\_, this is the ultimate contradiction. We are not part of this kingdom. Our inheritance lies in the \_\_\_\_\_ kingdom of Jesus Christ.
