



- Satan specializes in bringing strong feelings of insecurity, but:

**In Christ, I am secure.**

**The Bible explains to us why this is true.**

**1. Because I am *free* from condemnation.  
Romans 8:31-34**

- *“Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that heareth my word, and believeth on him that sent me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life.” John 5:24*
- If you are in Christ, He is **standing** up for you in heaven, and you are free from the eternal condemnation of Satan.

**2. Because I cannot be separated from the  
*love* of Christ. Romans 8:35-39**

- You are not loved because of your works or your performance. You are loved because of **who** you are in Christ.

3. **Because I have been *sealed* by God's Spirit. 2 Corinthians 1:21-22**
4. **Because I have not been given the spirit of *fear*. 2 Timothy 1:7**
  - *"For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind."* 2 Timothy 1:7
  - If you are in Christ, you don't have to allow fear to ***control*** you and bring insecurity.
5. **Because I am assured that *all* things work together for good. Romans 8:28**

**In Conclusion:**

- Satan does not want you to know this truth -  
**You are *forever* secure in Christ!**

# Accepted in Christ

**In Christ, I am fully accepted.**

**The Bible explains to us why this is true.**

- 1. Because I am a member of Christ's *body*. Ephesians 5:30**
- 2. Because I have been *justified*.**
  - *"Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ."* **Romans 5:1**
  - To be justified means "to be declared righteous."
- 3. Because I am a *saint*. Philippians 1:1**
  - *"Unto the church of God which is at Corinth, to them that are sanctified in Christ Jesus, called to be saints, with all that in every place call upon the name of Jesus Christ our Lord, both theirs and ours."* **1 Corinthians 1:2**
- 4. Because I have been *adopted* as God's child. Galatians 4:4-7**

5. **Because I have been redeemed and forgiven. Ephesians 1:5-7**

6. **Because I am *complete* in Christ. Colossians 2:10**

- *“And ye are complete in him, which is the head of all principality and power.”*  
**Colossians 2:10**

**In Conclusion:**

- Satan cannot do anything about your ***position*** in Christ, but he knows he can frustrate and hinder you if he can keep you blinded to ***who*** you are in Christ.



- There are only two possibilities for every person in the world:

You are either in your **sins**,

- *“I said therefore unto you, that ye shall die in your sins: for if ye believe not that I am he, ye shall die in your sins.”* **John 8:24**

Or you are in **Christ**.

- *“Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.”* **2 Corinthians 5:17**
- If my life is to have true meaning and significance, it is found in the resurrected Christ. Why is this?

### **Because once I am in Christ:**

#### **1. I am God’s temple.**

- *“Know ye not that ye are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwelleth in you?”*  
**1 Corinthians 3:16**

#### **2. I am God’s workmanship.**

- *“For we are his (God’s) workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works...”*  
**Ephesians 2:10a**

- When God creates you a new person in Christ, you are His workmanship and He has a **plan** for your life - your life has new purpose.

### 3. I am **seated** with Christ in heaven.

- *“And hath raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus.”*  
**Ephesians 2:6**

### 4. I may approach God with **freedom**.

- *“For through him (Christ) we both have access by one Spirit unto the Father.”* **Ephesians 2:18**
- When you are in Christ, you have free entrance into God’s presence to **talk** to Him at any time.

*Jesus died for your sins and rose from the dead so that you could be **forgiven** of all your sins and clothed in Christ’s righteousness. True meaning and significance is found in Christ.*

*Will you turn to Christ and receive Him as your Savior today?*
